Anniversary Edition

The idea for the Dayton History News was conceived by Caroline Wadzeck, Dayton's current Mayor. She showed an example to Janette Frick one Saturday afternoon in the summer of 2017 at the Old School Museum.

Based on the example, Janette created a prototype and after a few adjustments, the first of the Dayton History News series was published.

Caroline knew Janette as a fellow member of the Dayton Historical Society and knew about her passion for writing because the museum had a copy of Janette's published book entitled Christianity Made Simple that had won three national awards.

Another ingredient was passion for history. Janette had already been accepted into the Daughters of the Republic of Texas and the Daughters of the American Revolution based on persistence in the genealogical research required to prove lineage.

The other ingredient was passion for Dayton history. Janette was already a member of the Dayton Historical Society and regularly attended the meetings.

She grew up in Dayton and attended Dayton schools starting in 1962 – graduating from Dayton High School in 1973 as an honor graduate with multiple scholarships.

Since her parents Eddie and Faye Goulder and her siblings Von and Don lived in Dayton most of their lives, it has always been "home" and the place she moved to upon retirement.

But what about perseverance? In the years after graduating from Dayton High School, Janette attained a Bachelor's degree from University of Houston's School of Business in Management Information Systems.

She also achieved a Master's degree from Georgetown University in project management.

Much of her advanced education was accomplished while working full-time at Exxon Production Research (Houston), Northrop Electronics (Los Angeles), Boeing Information Systems (Seattle) and Boeing Space Exploration (Clearlake).

The result – the Dayton History News has indeed been a success with many Dayton citizens looking forward to each new edition.
